- SEVC 2020 congress needs to coincide with WSAVA 2020.
- A joint congress protocol including the financial model needs to be signed with AVEPA by1 November 2016. KI needs to decide on the most suitable venue. Should agreement not be reached by 1 November 2016, the bid will revert to PSAVA for WSAVA 2020 to be hosted in Poland. This will be subject to the acceptance of the offer by PSAVA.
